Major gateway through the city walls.

Minor gateway or modern arch.

Water Tower to Lendal Tower via Bootham Tower (area shaded yellow).

4: York City Walls (North)

Bootham Bar to Lathorp (a.k.a. Layerthorpe) Tower.

2: York City Walls (Southwest)

Skeldergate Access Tower to Barker Tower.

6: York City Walls (Southeast)

Red Tower to Fishergate Postern Tower.

1: York Castle

5: River Foss & King's Fishpond.
